### COURSE CONTENT:

- Relaxed group discussion introducing the syllabus to all drivers of both PCV and LGV to be approved by: - **Joint Approvals Unit for Periodic Training (JAUPT)**
- Group discussion to highlight delegates experiences and develop positive attitudes to collision avoidance and interacting with all road users, identify how drivers' expectations can often cloud their appreciation of risks.
- The principles of defensive driving and highlight the key elements of Information, Assessment and Decisions, reflecting on the importance of maintaining concentration levels.
- Group exercise providing drivers with a series of Pre-Collision scenarios where drivers failed to recognise the developing stages of the collision using observation links to assist with collision avoidance. The exercise encourages delegates to process information as early as possible allowing them to formulate early solutions to developing situations.
