BESPOKE OBJECTIVES:

The following objectives can be included if required: -

1. First responder training

COURSE CONTENT:

- Relaxed group discussion introducing the syllabus to all drivers of both PCV and LGV to be approved by: - **Joint Approvals Unit for Periodic Training (JAUPT)**
- Group demonstration and practical in relation to first aid priorities together with the approach and management of a scene.
- Primary survey of a casualty with basic life support. (Dr A.B.C) together with examination of the casualty – 'top to toe' survey.
- Dealing with unconsciousness and the recovery position and an insight into dealing with heart attacks, stroke, and shock – F.A.S.T.
- A demonstration in how to deal with burns, scalds and choking, together with wounds, bleeding, and fractures.
- Injuries within the workplace including crush, eye injuries and people with hypoglycaemia.
