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# TYRE SAFETY & WHEEL SECURITY

## AIM OF COURSE:

To provide drivers with an understanding of the importance of recognising sidewall information and the correct and safe use of tyres, wheel security, enhancing the driver walk round checks ensuring that driving licence and O Licence are not compromised.

## BESPOKE OBJECTIVES:

The following objectives can be included if required: -

1. Recognition of tyre sizes, load / speed indices and other sidewall markings to enhance safety.
2. Drivers will be able to use this knowledge to increase their professionalism in the driver walk round checks.

## COURSE CONTENT:

- Relaxed group discussion introducing the syllabus to all drivers of both PCV and LGV to be approved by: - **Joint Approvals Unit for Periodic Training (JAUPT)**
- Tyre Construction- Drivers are provided with an in depth understanding which explains how complex a tyre construction is underlining the need to confirm its safe use on the vehicle. Load / Speed index of Tyres and their legal implications to ensure tyres are used within their safe performance capability at all times.
- Functions of a Tyre – Requires drivers to provide their understanding of what the tyre must provide and more importantly what factors greatly reduce the tyre's function compromising safety.
- Tyre Recognition – tyre sizes and other sidewall markings, explanation of all sidewall markings and why it is important to have the correct tyre which is safe and suitable for the purpose used.
- Wheel security checks and re torque policies.
